


DETERMINE YOUR TYPE OF DRAWER SLIDE




BALL-BEARING

Mounted on the side of the drawer.

Mounting Accessory (item #D688SEE-W-CP)

required for mounting slides in
face-frame cabinets.

Professional-grade construction with a smooth glide.



▶ self-close & standard close available

SOFT-CLOSE VS SELF-CLOSE

► SOFT-CLOSE //

Engages to slowly pull the drawer closed & help prevent slamming.
Also helps prevent the drawer from opening again due to bumps or jostling once closed.

▶ SELF-CLOSE //

Helps prevent the drawer from opening again due to bumps or jostling once closed.

ROLLER SLIDES


Mounted on the bottom corner of the drawer.

Mounting Accessory (item #D688SEE-W-CP)

required for mounting slides in

face-frame cabinets.


Painted, metal frame with a roller wheel that moves the drawer when pushed.






MEASURING YOUR SLIDE LENGTH



Top view of cabinet

FACE FRAME CABINET DRAWERS

Measure the depth of the entire cabinet, from the exterior face frame edge to the very back of the cabinet wall. This measurement is the length of the drawer slide you need.



Top view of cabinet

FRAMELESS CABINET DRAWERS

Measure the length of your cabinet drawer from front to back. This measurment is the drawer slide length you will need
